Highlight

A highlight of the tour is when the entire bus, sitting on the water, is reflected on the glass exterior of Hachikenya (the point of departure).

Please arrive **15mins** before your departure time.



Access



From the Subway Tanimachi Line

Take the Tenmabashi North Ticket Gate's A staircase (facing Minami-morimachi) to the Keihan train line.
Go out exit ⑰ and turn left. Walk 100m along the river. It is the building on the left.

From the Keihan Train Line

Go out exit ⑰ from Tenmabashi Station's West Ticket Gate (facing Yodoyabashi) and turn left. Walk 100m along the river. It is the building on the left

Tour Info

*Please make sure to read the following before making your application.

- Reservations can be made from the 1st of the month 2 months prior to the month of your tour. We accept single person applications.
- For groups of 20 or more, please contact us as the dates and conditions differ from standard tours.
- On the day of your tour, please arrive at the reception counter 15mins before your departure. Reception opens 30mins before departure times.
- The minimum number of passengers needed to hold the tour is 10. When this number is not met, you will be notified 4 days in advance.
- The amphibious bus is open-air. Please bring a raincoat in the event of rain. (tours are held rain or shine)
- There is a set of 5 steps, 30cm tall, used for boarding and exiting the bus.
- There is no bag storage on the bus. Please use the coin lockers found nearby for your luggage.
- The bus does not carry a heating/air conditioning unit. We still recommend you to dress warm in winter.
- Please refrain from bringing food and drink onto the bus. Smoking is prohibited.
- Please be aware that tours may be cancelled or courses/times changed without prior warning as a result of weather, water levels, company policies, traffic conditions, vehicle maintenance, river construction, public events, etc.
- Children of elementary school age and younger are required to put on a life vest.
- There are no bathrooms on the bus. Please visit the restroom before boarding.
- A passenger list is required. Please provide the names, gender, age, address (hotel name), and passport numbers of all passengers.

1



Osaka Mint

This facility produces coins, medals, metallic handicrafts and other metal-related objects. The gold, silver and bronze medals for the Tokyo and Nagano Olympics were created here.

2



Osaka Castle

This castle was constructed by Hideyoshi Toyotomi in 1583 as part of his effort to unify the country. Beginning with the Otomon Gate, Osaka Castle features various Important Cultural Properties, and its main tower has been made a Registered Tangible Cultural Property.

Fujita Museum

A hallowed hall of Oriental art, including nine National Treasures. The rare "Gohen Tenmoku tea bowl," one of only three in the world, is a must-see. Enjoy gardens and a tea house where you can forget the city's bustle.

Senpukan

Designated as a National Important Cultural Property, this building was originally a reception house for the mint. On the inside, it is ornately fitted with fireplaces, chandeliers and high ceilings.

Tenjinbashi-suji Shopping Arcade

2.6km in length and holding approximately 600 shops, this shopping arcade is renowned for being the longest in Japan.

Former Metropolitan Residences

Originally a hall for international conferences, the 'Osaka Metropolitan Residences' are now used for weddings. For a luxurious and hospitable time, check out its chapel, party venues and rooftop terrace.

Umeda Air Intake Tower

This stainless steel artwork by Togo Murano is located in the ventilation facility of Whity Umeda, the underground shopping complex in Umeda. Its beautiful streamlined form is illuminated at night, creating a fantastical atmosphere. It is a "sculpture-like masterpiece of architecture."

Bank of Japan, Osaka Branch

A symbol of Nakanoshima lined with historic buildings. Its magnificent exterior, modeled after a Belgian bank, is captivating. Inside, visitors can tour the VIP lounge and vault, and experience the weight of 100 million yen.
